- A highly weather resistant vapor permeable WRB for building envelopes
- Use with SIP-SEAL Liquid Flashing to form a continuous water-resistant skin
- Ready to use, cures in the presence of moisture
- Will not harden, yellow, or lose flexibility
- UV stable (no change at 2,000 UV-A hours)
- Resists Hydrostatic Pressure 21.6 in @ 30 days
- Adheres to wood, gypsum, concrete, metal, EPS, poly ISO and polyurethane foam, plus most other non-asphaltic substrates
- Will not leach plasticizers
- Cured product is non-tacky

- Will not freeze
- Application temperature best above 40°F colder temperatures extend the cure rate
  Apply to a clean, dry, frost-free surface.
  Apply Liquid Membrane by roller, trowel or high-pressure spray
  Check for any pin holes or voids and recoat if needed; membrane continuity is important
  Use with adequate ventilation, inhalation of vapor during application and cure may cause slight eye and throat irritation
  In case of contact with eyes, lips, or mouth flush thoroughly with water. If irritation persists, consult a physician. Do not swallow
  - Avoid repeated, prolonged contact to skin
